Dear Fellow Montgomery Historical Society Member,

Here's the latest update on an easy and cost free way for you to help us.

The MHS registered for the TD Bank Affinity Program (AP) in 2009. This program is used by the Bank to support civic groups and charities. Under this program TD Bank makes an annual donation to the Society if at least 25% of our memberships (about 50) are account holders and designate the Society as their AP partner. TD Bank donates a minimum of \$500 annually, and possibly more based on the average annual balances in those eligible accounts. In essence, the more money in these accounts, the more TD Bank will donate to the Society.

All information about participation and accounts is kept by TD Bank according to their privacy policies. None is shared with the Society. We will simply be told if we meet the eligibility criteria and, if so, be given \$500 or more at the end of the 12 month payment period.

GREAT NEWS: We qualified for a TD Affinity grant in 2016 of \$4,276. This is our seventh Affinity check in a row totaling just under \$45,000. A big THANK YOU, once again, to all our Affinity members.

We need to keep our Affinity numbers up if we are to remain eligible. If you are already our Affinity Program partner, thank you. You don't need to do anything to remain in the program. If you are not, please consider joining up.
