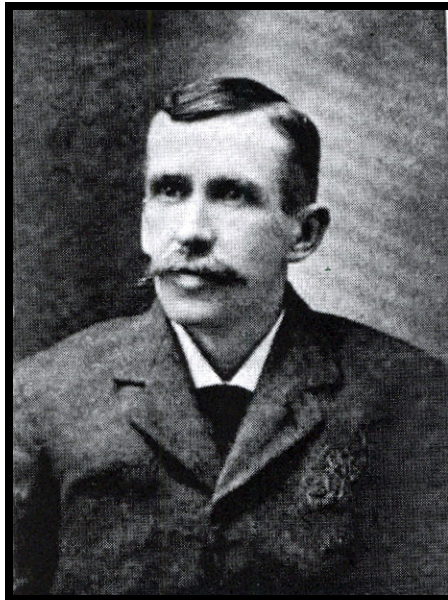

MARTIN, CHARLES L., was born in Montgomery, February 18, 1861; educated in the common schools, St. Johnsbury Academy, and graduated from Eastman's Business College, February 18, 1880. He has been superintendent of schools six years, selectman three years, school director four years, justice of the peace two years and has been town clerk for six years. In 1902 and again in 1904 he represented Montgomery in the General Assembly. In politics Mr. Martin is a sturdy Republican.
